News from Human Resources

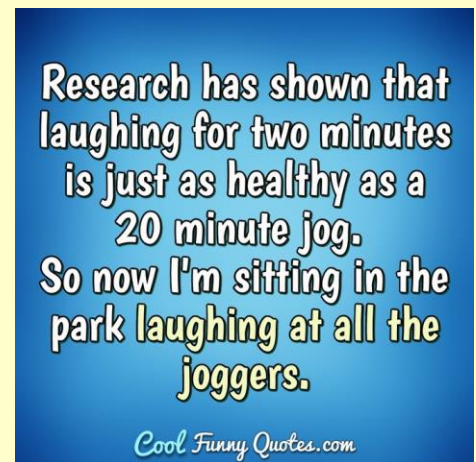
Hello Everyone,
