

Hello Everyone,

-Just a reminder that open enrollment for Health, Dental and Vision insurance is December 1st through December 31st for the January 1, 2020 plan year. Please have your enrollment or change forms back to me by December 11th, 2019.

-Watch your mailboxes for information on the benefit changes taking place January 1st, 2020.

Health Insurance – We have decided to stay with Security Health Plan. Two options are available for you to choose from. The Security Health Plan Discover network is free for all employees, or you can choose the Premier Plan with a buy up option. If you are currently enrolled in our Health Insurance plan and I don't get a response from you by December 11th, 2019, we will automatically enroll you in the Security Health Plan's Discover Plan.

Dental Insurance- We have decided to move to the Beam Dental Care Plan. Beam Dental offers the same dental benefits you have been used to in the past with lower premiums and so much more. If you are currently enrolled in the MetLife Dental Plan and I don't get a response from you by December 11th, 2019, we will automatically enroll you in the Beam Dental Plan.

Vision Insurance – We have decided to add a full Vision Plan to the Haas benefit package. Beam Vision offers Employees significate discounts on vision expenses.

Life Insurance – We are keeping the same plan as last year with Unum Life. There is no increase in cost to you.
